- Assisting WVU Extension Office with nutrition classes in primary schools. Will also assist them with Dining with Diabetes Program.
- Presented slide show presentation regarding Harm Reduction (needle exchange)
 Program with Brooke & Hancock Counties. Reviewed overdose death rates. West Virginia is five times higher than average. Ohio County has a successful needle exchange program that reduces the spread of disease and risk to responders. The program also offers help getting the addict into counseling.

- Mid-year financial report reviewed and approved.
- Mediation meeting regarding the pending civil action is scheduled at the Courthouse tomorrow at 1:00 p.m.
- Jim Andreozzi congratulated the Board for what has been accomplished and looks forward to helping with some of our issues.
- Christina Mickey said that all West Virginia counties have clean air regulations and 33 have regulations similar to ours. There have been 12 lawsuits and they have all been upheld by the Supreme Court.
